<u>Credit System</u> 25 credits are required for graduation.

Students earn 0.5 credits for each semester course successfully completed earning a passing grade of D or above except PE I where students earn 0.25 credit per semester. Students do not earn high school credit for Dual Enrollment/E2C (Early Entry College) courses and they are not listed on the high school transcript.

Response to Covid-19

<u>March 2020</u> - St. Bede Academy abruptly migrated to real-time online learning. Courses met virtually with their instructors following their regular school schedule.

<u>August 2020</u> - The school year began with real-time online classes for all students. After 2 weeks, students returned to a blended model attending in-person classes four days a week and real-time online classes four days a week. All sports and activities were canceled.

<u>January 2021</u> - Students returned to in-person classes 5 days a week with several short term shut downs. During the shut downs all courses were presented in a real-time online format. Limited sport seasons and activities resumed in the late spring.

<u>August 2020 - June 2021</u> students required to quarantine and families who are uncomfortable returning to school are provided the option of real-time online learning following their regular class schedule.

<u>August 2021</u> -The 2021-22 school year began with a regular in-person 5 day a week schedule. All sports and activities have resumed a regular schedule.

<u>Since the beginning of the pandemic - December 2021</u> students and staff were required to wear a mask and social distance during all in-door, in-person learning, sports and activities.

<u>As a result</u>, students are encouraged to factor academics, mental health, and life balance when choosing courses in this new environment.
