Celebrating the 125th Anniversary of St. Bede Academy

On June 15, 1861, the Benedictine monks of Saint Vincent Archabbey in Latrobe, Pennsylvania, arrived in Chicago, and took charge of St. Joseph Church. The monks of St. Joseph in 1889 petitioned their motherhouse for permission to establish a college in the diocese of Peoria and on May 15, 1889 the Daniel Webster farm in Bureau County was purchased for what would become St. Bede Academy. Saint Bede College opened on September 7, 1891 with a faculty of 6 and 60 students. Through our history, though times may have changed, St. Bede lives on and not only in our halls, but in our hearts and minds. Our tradition remains strong and is the foundation of the "Spirit of St. Bede." We celebrate our history, our tradition, and our family that bonds us, a bond that will always remain with us. Celebrate our spirit, the spirit of St. Bede. We are so blessed. "May the Rule of St. Benedict be our guide, may the Spirit of St. Bede stay with us forever."

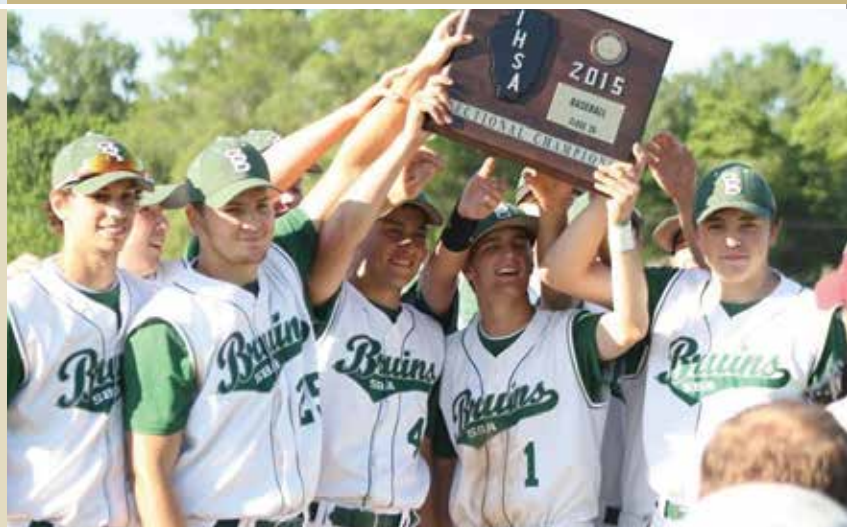


Track

Baseball

The Bruins Baseball team, coached by Bill Booker, Mike Bima, Jim Eustice, and Ed Mitchell, placed 4th in the 2A State Finals, finishing with a 23-10 record. This is the first year since 1992 that St. Bede Baseball has gone to State. Junior Jarret Olson was awarded Player of the Year in the Three Rivers Athletic Conference, along with three senior players awarded all conference: Jack Brady, 1st team, Matt Szczepaniak, 2nd team, and Gabe Braboy, 2nd team. The Bruins tied for 1st place in the Three Rivers Athletic Conference.





Bernie Moore *41 years*

Mr. Bernie Moore began his career at St. Bede in 1974. During his 41 years, he taught Algebra 1 & 2, Geometry, Pre-Calc, Business Math, Applied Math, and Trigonometry. He also coached for many years, including boys golf for 1 year, girls golf for 6 years, football for 20 years, track for 13 years, boys basketball with 17 years as assistant coach and 6 years as head coach, and scholastic bowl for 3 years. Mr. Moore served as the athletic director for 20 years but may be best known for his position as the

Dean of Students/Assistant Principal, which he served for 38 years. He claims he has "too many to choose one or two" favorite memories, but baseball state championship, 4th place softball, starting the wrestling program, state champ and runner up in hurdles, and his son and daughter graduating in 1988 and 2001 just to name a few. His favorite part about teaching at St. Bede was, "the feeling of pride to see students succeed." Mr. Moore left his St. Bede family with this: "Whatever I did at St. Bede, in whatever capacity, I started and finished, a teacher. What a great career it has been."

John Bellino '68 *40 years*

Mr. John Bellino '68 began his St. Bede career in 1975, teaching history, PE, and health. Coach Bellino leaves St. Bede with decades of winning seasons of football, baseball, and basketball coaching behind him. He coached football from 1980-2014 with a record of 176-161, 15 state playoff appearances, a semi-final appearance in 2001, and a quarterfinal appearance in 2011. He coached baseball from 1978-2014 with a record of 625-347-3, 12 regional titles, 2 sectional titles, and 1 state championship (1988). Coach Bellino holds the record for the most

coaching seasons as head coach for both football and baseball. His three sons, John '06, Andy '08, and Michael '14 all attended St. Bede. His wife, Susan, could be found in the stands at almost every game. He has many fond memories from his time at St. Bede but at the top of the list is taking the 1988 state championship for baseball. He will miss coaching and teaching in general and looks back on all of his teams fondly.

Mrs. Leann Wilcoxen, otherwise known as Señora Wilcoxen, began her journey at St. Bede in 1983. Throughout her 32 years, she taught Spanish I, II, III, and IV, and even English III for one year. Señora is well-known for her dedication to her students, which is shown through her involvement in numerous extra-curricular activities. She served as moderator for Spanish Club, Pep Club, Service Club, and 10 years on Prom Committee. In addition, she has taken students on a total of 10 Europe trips

throughout the years. "I have had many wonderful memories and have always been proud to work at St. Bede and represent it at Foreign Language conferences around the nation. My favorite experience is usually the one I am in at the moment. It has truly been a blessing to be able to enjoy every step of this journey, cheer the Bruin teams on and 'Bleed Green.'" She said she will miss her students and their "enthusiasm for life," as well as her colleagues. "What a team we made," she said, "each one of us contributing something unique and valuable to enrich and continue the Spirit of St. Bede." She leaves her St. Bede family with this: "Bloom where you are planted. Make the best of your life so that at the end of the day, the week, the year, and your career, you can feel joy and pride in what you have accomplished."

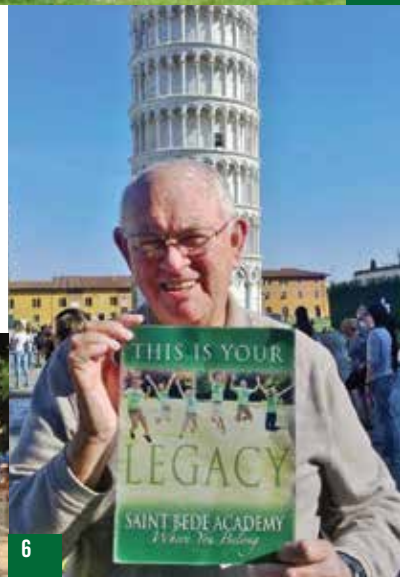

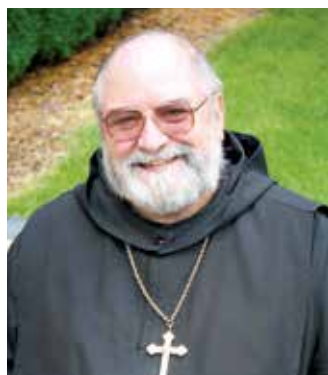

Golden Jubilee Rev. Harold Datzman, O.S.B.

Rev. Harold Datzman, O.S.B. celebrated 50 years in priesthood on Sunday, May 24, 2015. His golden anniversary was celebrated with a Mass at St. Joseph Church in Peru, one of the parishes where he served as pastor and/or assistant pastor over the past 40 years. He graduated from St. Bede in 1956 and found more than an education. It was during his senior year at St. Bede that he decided to become a priest. Father Harold was ordained on May 23, 1965 by Bishop John B. Franz at St. Mary's Cathedral in Peoria. After studying two years at St. Bede Junior College, he professed his vows as a monk in 1959. After completing his theology studies at St. John's University, Conception Abbey, he earned his master's degree at the University of Detroit. He was assigned to St. Joseph Church in Peru and was parochial vicar there from 1977-1984. He then served as pastor and administrator in Cherry, Arlington, Dalzell, Ladd, and Seatonville before returning to St. Joseph's Church where he has been pastor since 2005.

Father Henry Fritz, O.S.B.



Father Henry Fritz, O.S.B. died Sunday morning, July 6, 2014, at St. Margaret's Hospital, Spring Valley, several days after suffering from a severe stroke. He generously served St. Bede Abbey and the diocese of Peoria for almost 70 years. He was 89.

Father Henry was born April 3, 1925, the son of Henry and Marie Fritz, in Chicago, Illinois. The family moved to Pontiac in 1926, where Henry entered St. Mary's Grade School and worked a variety of farm jobs. After attending high school and college at St. Bede, where he was very much involved in religious activities and athletics, he entered the novitiate at St. John's Abbey, Collegeville, MN in 1945. He received a BA from St. John's University and a master's in economics from Notre Dame. He made his first profession of vows on July 11, 1946, took his solemn vows on July 11, 1949, and was ordained a priest May 22, 1952.

Father Henry worked at St. Bede Academy for 33 years. He taught history, political science and economics from 1952 until 1977, when he was appointed principal. He also served as guidance counselor, yearbook moderator, and the first softball coach when softball was introduced as the first interscholastic sport for girls. While Father Henry would have been the first person to admit he couldn't sing and knew very little about music, he, with great gusto, did a stint as band director. During his tenure as principal, he instituted the annual dinner auction in support of the Academy.

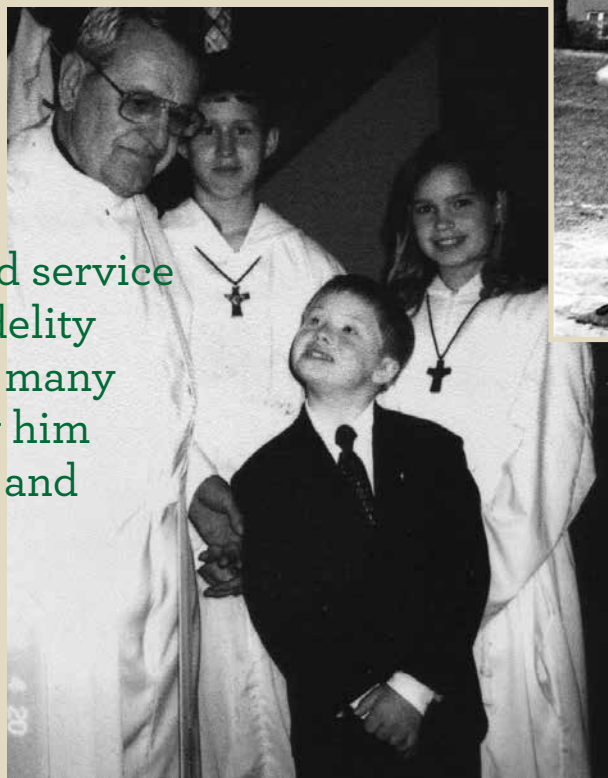
In 1985 he began a series of parish assignments throughout the Peoria diocese, including assistant, St. Mary, Pontiac, 1985; pastor, St. Peter, Peoria, 1986; St. Francis, Kewanee, and St. John, Cambridge, 1987 and again in 2010-2012; St. Joseph, Peru, 1994; pastor, St. Joseph, Peru, and administrator, St. Mary, Peru, 2001; pastor, St. Benedict, Ladd, 2005. Father Henry was tireless in his service at these parishes. When the new rectory was being built at St. Joseph's he lived in a windowless room in the gym to save money. After he retired to the abbey in 2012 he continued to be in contact with people from the parishes he served.

Father Roger Corpus, O.S.B.



Father Roger Corpus, O.S.B. priest and retired abbot of St. Bede Abbey, passed away peacefully on Sunday, May 24, 2015. He was 84.

He was born in Peru Illinois on July 14, 1930, to Francis and Honorine Corpus, and was named Francis after his father. He had one sister, Charlene, and he remained very close with her and her family throughout his life. He attended grade school at St. Joseph's parish school, followed by high school and junior college at St. Bede. He entered the monastic

community in 1950 and professed vows on July 11, 1951, taking the name Roger. Two years later, he earned a bachelor's degree from St. John's University in Collegeville, MN, and then returned to St. Bede for four years of theology studies. He was ordained to the priesthood on June 2, 1957.

From 1957 to 1990 he taught English, photography and film making at St. Bede Academy and earned a master's degree in communication arts from the University of Notre Dame during summer sessions. As a teacher he was known as being patient and gentle, but also demanding. Former students often spoke of his influence in helping them "see with a photographer's eye" and to view films as more than mere entertainment. He also served the Academy for periods as infirmarian, prefect of the boarding school, and moderator of the Mothers' Club.

In 1981 he was made prior of St. Bede Abbey, serving from 1981 to 1985. In 1986 he took part in a month-long monastic renewal program at Collegio Sant'Anselmo in Rome, and was then re-assigned as prior from 1987 to 1990. On June 8, 1990, he was elected the sixth abbot of St. Bede, and was re-elected in 1998. During his tenure, development efforts for St. Bede Abbey and Academy were integrated and revitalized.

When he resigned as abbot in 2003, Bishop Daniel R. Jenky appointed him administrator of St. Mary's Parish in El Paso, and he was named pastor two years later. Despite having limited experience in pastoral administration, he was successful in creating a strong parish community. Parishioners were especially grateful for his ministry to the sick and for his comfort and compassion during times of struggle or tragedy. He served at St. Mary's until his retirement to St. Bede in 2014, but kept in regular contact with many of his former parishioners.

Father Roger exemplified St. Benedict's injunction that the abbot must instruct his disciples more by deeds than by words, not only in his dedication to his religious duties but in his willingness to engage in manual labor. Even as abbot he could be seen at work in housekeeping and painting projects. As he aged Father Roger suffered from significant joint pains, digestive problems, and heart ailments which he bore with his customary patience and quiet dignity.
