ITINERARY

DAY 1: DEPART THE USA

Friday, April 26, 2024 - Depart from the USA for an overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal.

DAY 2: LISBON & ESTORIL

Saturday, April 27, 2024 - Upon arrival to Lisbon airport, meet and greet our tour director and transfer to the hotel. There will be some time to freshen up before we begin our *Welcome to Portugal* celebration. We start this amazing tour at nearby St. Antonio do Estoril Church for a private mass with Abbot Michael. This evening the celebration continues with a splendid happy hour to catch up with our OTBP family, followed by an introduction to Portuguese flavors and local cuisine in the hotel dining room.

DAY 3: LISBON & ESTORIL

Sunday, April 28, 2024 - Our day begins with breakfast in the hotel followed by a tour of the capital, passing by Belem quarter with Jerónimos Monastery, Belem tower and Discoveries monument. Then a panoramic tour of Eduardo VII Park and Liberty Avenue, Rossio and Comercio square. Later we meet the locals and learn about traditional Portuguese dishes as we embark on a Foodie Tour through the narrow streets of the Alfama neighborhood. Warm up your taste buds when experiencing the traditional codfish cakes with "PDO Serra da Estrela" filling. Let the flavors keep coming from the "CAN the CAN" a restaurant full of the "Portugality" located in the noblest Terreiro do Paço, where we taste several Portuguese traditional dishes spiced with the new cooking trends. We continue by discovering some sweet desserts of Portugal. Our foodie tour ends with the traditional taste of "Ginjinha" liqueur considered the drink of Lisbon that is made with sour cherries. The remaining afternoon is free in Lisbon with a late afternoon transfer back to the hotel. Tonight explore Estoril and all it has to offer.

DAY 4: ESTORIL, SINTRA & CASCAIS

Monday, April 29, 2024 - Enjoy a delicious breakfast before we set off for another day of exploration, this time to nearby Sintra. First we visit the **Sintra National Palace** and its enchanted village with many palaces. Enjoy a short walking tour through Sintra's quaint alleyways and home to one-of-a-kind shops and boutiques and of course some free time before we head to Caboda Roca, the most westerly point of mainland Europe, also known as the end of the world for a photo stop. We continue to the scenic coastal resort town of Cascais for a walking tour along the bay. Known for its bustling marina and gorgeous beaches it is the perfect place for free time to explore and have lunch. Your afternoon is free to enjoy the hotel facilities like the spa, golf or the nearby Casino Estoril and village. Dinner will be served at our famous James Bond hotel.

DAY 5: TOMAR & FATIMA

Tuesday, April 30, 2024 - Enjoy breakfast before we leave this hotel and embark on a journey back in time as we discover the hidden gems of Tomar and Fatima. Tomar is the most important place of the Templar history in the world. Discover the mesmerizing **Convent of Christ**, a UNESCO World Heritage site that boasts remarkable architectural wonders dating back centuries. Following the walking tour in the city center you will have free time for lunch. Our final destination is Fatima where we journey to one of the world's most important Catholic pilgrimage sites. On arrival we will **visit the houses of the little shepherds** in the village of Aljustrel and to the sanctuary for an orientation walking tour. Dinner will be at the hotel conveniently located near the night Rosary and candlelight procession.

DAY 6: NAZARE, AVEIRO & DOURO VALLEY

Wednesday, May 1, 2024 - After breakfast we depart from the hotel and travel to Nazaré. This once fishing village is now a popular beach resort, known worldwide when a Hawaiian surfed a 78-foot wave. On arrival visit **Sítio da Nazaré**, located in the highest most dramatic spot of the promontory where it's possible to visit the hermitage "Ermida da Memória" and admire the image of Our Lady that was found within a small cave in the year of 1182, and was said to be from Nazareth in Galilee. Continue to Aveiro, the eternal "Portuguese Venice". You will have free time for lunch. Take a walking tour in the city without missing the chance to taste "Ovos Moles" a traditional sweet created by the nuns of the ancient convents of Aveir

ro. Depart towards the Douro valley where a special stay awaits us at the Quinta da Pacheca. This is one of the most prestigious and recognized properties in the Douro demarcated region. The history of the vineyard property dates back to the XVI century when it was a collection of vines that belonged to the monasteries of Salzedas and St. João de Tarouca. The evening continues with a Fado show and dinner on this stunning property.

DAY 7: DOURO VALLEY

Thursday, May 2, 2024 - Sleep in and enjoy a late breakfast or take a stroll around the grounds. Mid-morning we begin a guided visit to the **winery gardens and vineyards** followed by a wine tasting. Become immersed in the local culture during a hands-on cooking class using local delicacies that will be our lunch of the day. This afternoon is free time to relax and enjoy the hotel facilities and services such as the spa and swimming pool. Tonight put on your dancing shoes for our OTBP dinner and dance party.

DAY 8: DOURO VALLEY, BRAGA & PORTO

Friday, May 3, 2024 - After breakfast we say goodbye to this beautiful property and travel to Singeverga Abbey located in Roriz village. It is the only monastery in Portugal following the Rule of St. Benedict. A Benedictine Monk will greet and guide us around the monastery with an opportunity to taste and learn about the special liqueur produced by the monks there. The Singeverga liqueur is produced by a careful selection of a great amount of aromatic and balsamic herbs, and it is the last and only liqueur produced by monks in Portugal. We continue to Braga for an afternoon visit to Bom Jesus Sanctuary and walking tour in the city downtown. Braga is one of the oldest cities in the country, dating back more than 2,000 years of existence. To get to the top of Bom Jesus Sanctuary we will take the **vertical tram**, an impressive piece of the 19th century engineering, the first of its kind to be installed in Portugal in 1882. Visit the church and walk the panoramic stairway, with 17 landings adorned with symbolic fountains, allegoric statues and other Baroque-style decorations along themes such as the Stations of the Cross, the Five Senses, the Virtues, Moses receiving the Commandments and at the top the eight biblical figures that contribute to the condemnation of Jesus. Depart to Porto for final destination of the day. Tonight we will enjoy dinner at the hotel.

DAY 9: PORTO

Saturday, May 4, 2024 - Let's begin our day with a hearty breakfast and then a morning visit of the city. Including a panoramic tour passing by Porto's Cathedral and Clérigos Tower. Visit to **Bolsa Palace** a UNESCO site located in the historical center of the city, built on the ruins of the Saint



Francis Convent. Walk along Ribeira quay, and free time for lunch on your own. Enjoy your afternoon for shopping and personal activities, join the optional visit to a Porto wine cellars with Port wine tasting



or opt for a relaxing afternoon at the spa facilities of the hotel. This

evening we will gather one last time for our Farewell to Portugal Celebration. We begin with a one-hour cruise along the Douro River on a traditional "Rabelo" boat that used to transport the Porto wine along the river. Take in the stunning views as the sky begins to change while enjoying Port wine on board. We end our evening with a local restaurant for Fado show & Folklore where our OTBP family will participate in the traditional dances.
